## Title of the course- Certificate course in Ayurveda cosmetology

**Objectives-** main objectives of the course is to blend traditional Ayurvedic principles with modern cosmetology for Holistic beauty and Wellness management  
To develop the competency in inside out beauty practices according to the Ayurveda principals

Duration - 6 months

Eligibility - BAMS

### Course structure

**Theory :** fundamentals of Ayurveda, fundamentals of cosmetology, anatomy and physiology of skin, Doshik assessment of skin and hair, along Lifestyle practices  
practical trainings :

A certificate course in Ayurvedic cosmetology integrates traditional Ayurvedic principles with modern cosmetic practices. The curriculum blends theoretical knowledge of Ayurvedic concepts, such as doshas (body constitutions), with hands-on training in natural beauty treatments and herbal product formulation.

### Foundational concepts

- **Ayurvedic fundamentals:** Introduces core concepts like the Panchamahabhuta (five elements) and the Tridosha (Vata, Pitta, and Kapha) theory and their specific effects on skin and hair.
- **Anatomy and physiology:** Covers the basic anatomy and function of skin, hair, and nails from both Ayurvedic and modern perspectives.
- **Diet and lifestyle:** Educates on how nutrition, daily routine (Dinacharya), and seasonal routines (Ritucharya) influence skin and hair health.
- **Ayurvedic Saundarya Vigyan:** Explores the Ayurvedic concept of beauty, the internal and external factors that affect it, and the importance of overall wellness (Swasthya).
- **Concept of Kshudra Roga and their management**



## Practical applications and therapies

- **Herbal formulations:** Teaches the identification, properties, and use of various herbs, plant extracts, and natural ingredients in cosmetic preparations.
- **Herbal skincare:** Covers the preparation and application of natural cleansers, scrubs (Ubtan), face packs (Mukhalepam), and oils for different skin types and conditions. Includes treatments for common skin issues like acne, pigmentation, and dryness. Medi Facials along with knowledge of preparation of herbo-cosmetic products
- **Ayurvedic hair and scalp care:** Explores hair types according to doshas and provides remedies for hair problems like hair fall, dandruff, and premature greying. Covers the preparation of herbal hair oils and masks.
- **Beauty therapies:** Provides hands-on training for various Ayurvedic cosmetic procedures, which may include:
  - **Mukhabhyanga:** Ayurvedic facial massage.
  - **Shiro Abhyanga:** Traditional head massage.
  - **Shirodhara:** A continuous stream of medicated oil poured over the forehead for deep relaxation.
  - **Udvardhana:** Herbal powder massage for exfoliation and toning.
  - **Nasya:** Nasal instillation of herbal oils for holistic facial health.
  - **Medi Facials :** a complete procedure with facial rejuvenation
  - **Basic Knowledge of Collagen Induction Therapies :** Microneedling, Mesotherapy etc
- **Product creation:** Instructs on the preparation of various Ayurvedic cosmetic products, such as soaps, shampoos, lip balms/ Lip sticks, Serum, Tooth paste, Face Packs , lotion , creams, face wash

## Advanced and special topics

- **Cosmetology and modern practices:** Some advanced courses may incorporate knowledge of modern cosmetology equipment and integrate them with Ayurvedic treatments.
- **Ayurvedic psychology:** Addresses the mind-body connection and how emotional health impacts external beauty, incorporating lifestyle and stress management techniques.
- **Business and regulations:** Includes topics on the legal and regulatory aspects of selling Ayurvedic products, entrepreneurship in cosmetology, and basic product quality control.
- **Face Yoga**
- **Anatomy physiology of skin**

### Course assessment

Certification is typically awarded after successfully completing a course that involves:

- A written examination to test theoretical knowledge. 100 marks with minimum 50% Passing Marks
- A practical examination to assess hands-on skills in performing Ayurvedic cosmetic procedures. Live demonstration of the Procedures and skill by the candidate and Viva. 100 marks with minimum 50% Passing Marks.
